Federation co-funded research opportunities were discussed. Dr. Mandy Carr-Johnson will be asked to provide proposals for consideration in NDBC priority areas of Human Nutrition and Product Quality.

The ND Stockmen's Association convention had checkoff topics on the agenda including: Dr. Shalene McNeill with the NCBA research and nutrition program addressing work on beef's role in the diet and the Dietary Guidelines; Helbling, Maddock and Price on a panel discussing checkoff highlights at the local, state and national level; and Dvorak spoke at the Foundation lunch.

Wardner gave an update on presentations she gave to 44 youth at the Tomorrow's Top Hands event and 35 students in a Bismarck State College livestock production class. She also reported on the children's reading program, Build Your Base, and holiday promotions.

Bateman updated on high school and college sports advertising, living ag classroom changes and producer communications.

Helbling complemented Wardner and Bateman on their expertise filming his and Lachenmeier's producer food videos.

Bateman gave an update on office space, the policy manual is still being worked on, and she reported that two researchers have requested no-cost extensions due to Covid related delays in their research.
