- Lachenmeier updated on meetings of the SBARE livestock granting committee. There were research requests from NDSU totally \$199,000 but only \$114,000 available for grants.
- Bateman updated on upcoming ND Nutrition Council webinar speaker sponsorship as well as a speaker sponsorship for the ND Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics.
- Wardner updated on a new Bismarck Larks and Fargo Red Hawks baseball sponsorship program that is being developed.
